coming up to teach the girls.

15 May 1909 Queen - exact five minutes after
Somerset step-dance. Sam Bennett - 5 May 1909

28 July 1909 - Manny Pnt & W. G. Zelte - "hitherto we invited our original instructors in so as to be sure that not only the steps, but the form & spirit of the dances were being kept true to tradition."
